Nemo Vista High School SMART Goals

Long-Term Goal: In the 2024-2025 school year, the number of students scoring within grade level or at the level of proficient/exceeding in ELA (9th-10th), Algebra I, Geometry, and Biology on the ATLAS state End of Course exams will be over 65%.

a. **Short-Term Goal:** On the 2024-2024 STAR (Math & Reading) & ATLAS interim assessments, those students not proficient/exceeding will work on RTI to improve scores each assessment.

Long-Term Goal: In the 2024-2025 school year, the number of students in the 9th-12th grade enrolled in a certificate CTE, concurrent, or college prep program will be over 50%.

b. **Short-Term Goal:** In 2024-2025 all 9th-12th grade students will be on a career or college HS diploma route with a SMART objective tied to their Success Plan.

Long-Term Goal: In the 2024-2025 school year Nemo Vista HS will continue to promote and push for 90% of the combined number of students in 10th, 11th, & 12th to take some form of readiness in either the fall or spring of the School Year.

c. **Short-Term Goal:** In 2024-2025 90% of the combined number of students in the Sophomore, Junior, and Senior classes will have taken the Accuplacer, ACT Workkeys Readiness Assessment, or ACT.

Long-Term Goal: In the 2024-2025 school year the school will continue to promote and push for more service opportunities for students in the 9th grade (2028 graduates) & 10th grade (2027 graduates) to reach their acquired 75 hours of community service by their senior year.

d. **Short-Term Goal**: In the 2024-2025 school year at least 40% of 9th graders by the end of the year will have acquired 15 or more service hours and 50% of 10th graders will have acquired 40 or more service hours.
