We will continue Unit 1 *Sentences*. We will cover parts of a sentence, beginning and ending sentences, statements, questions, exclamations, and commands.

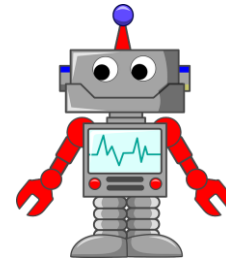

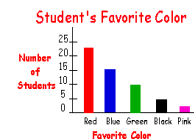

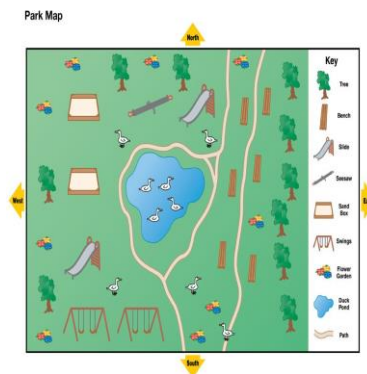
Handwriting
