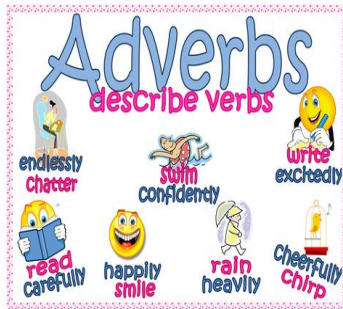
Unit 8 Week 2 "The Earth Shapers" and unit poem "Weather"

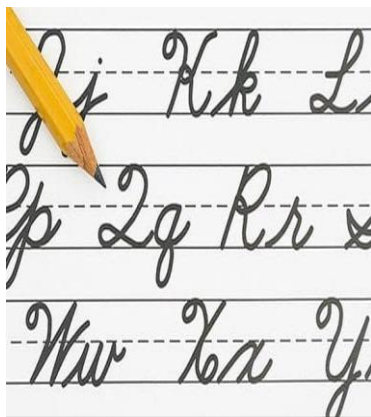
